- 3. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 4th May 2023.
- 4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Monday 17 April 2023. Applications can be made online: https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.
- 5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Elizabeth House, Walpole Loke, Dereham, Norfolk, NR19 1EE by 5 pm on Tuesday, 18th April 2023.
- 6. New Applications for Voter Authority Certificates at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Elizabeth House, Walpole Loke, Dereham, Norfolk, NR19 1EE by 5 pm on Tuesday, 25th April 2023. You must be registered to vote before you apply for a Voter Authority Certificate.

The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Tuesday, 25th April 2023.
