
Rocklands Sewer Project Road Closure Schedule (v2)

Due to the construction of a new sewer to serve dwellings North of Attleborough Road (B1077), there is a necessity for some unavoidable road closures and diversions for the duration of the works.

Below is a table listing the periods for which certain roads will be closed, and on page 2 is a map indicating the closures and necessary road diversions. A 'Businesses Open As Usual' sign will be posted at the North end of The Street.

Further information from Anglian Water is that, due to the delay in receiving their welfare units for the site compound, closure of **The Street** is now likely to begin from **Wednesday** onwards, and that **Chapel Street** will not be closed for **approximately another 2 weeks yet**. Therefore, there is an updated table below with (what should always be regarded now as <u>approximate</u>) revised dates. This, to the best of our knowledge, up-to-date at **25.09.22**.

| Thieves Lane | Road Closure | 06 Feb 23 – 14 Mar 23 |
| Chapel Street | Road Closure | 10 Oct 22 – 05 Jun 23 |
| St Peter's Close | Managed Access | 23 Jan 23 – 07 Mar 23 |

<u>The Street closure</u> – Bray's Lane (B1077) / Magpie Lane / The Street (and vice-versa)

<u>Chapel Street closure</u> – Bray's Lane (B1077) / Bell Lane / Bell Road / Chapel Street (and vice-versa)

<u>Thieves' Lane closure</u> – Attleborough Road/Watton Road (B1077) / Anchor Corner / Goose Common / Thieves' Lane (and vice-versa)
