NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (STRO9565) affecting Rockland Road from 160m south of its junction with Gravelpit Road for 130m southwards in the PARISHES OF STOW BEDON & BRECKLES to facilitate UK Power Networks new connection works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 4th to 8th September 2023 for the duration of the works expected to be about 5 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: B1077, Stow Bedon Road, A1075, B1111 (Shropham, Caston, Rocklands, Stow Bedon and Breckles).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
