Applicants should note that Councillors are expected to attend regular approximately bi-monthly meetings on Mondays in ROCKLANDS Village Hall, and any additional meetings as may be arranged, and to represent the electors of ROCKLANDS in raising and discussing those issues of interest and concern on which the Parish Council is empowered to act. Applicants should also note that membership of the Council is open to electors who are citizens of any state in the European Union or of the Commonwealth and

- Whose residence is in ROCKLANDS or within three miles of ROCKLANDS, or
- Whose principal place of work is in (ROCKLANDS), and
- Who is not disqualified (by reason of a criminal record, bankruptcy or involvement in corrupt practices).

Applicants are asked to give brief reasons for offering their services to the Council. Please complete the application form and return to the Clerk as soon as possible for the councillors to consider before the 2 September meeting..

Co-option of a new councillor will be on the agenda for the next Parish Council meeting to be held on **Monday 2 September 2019**. Should there be more than one applicant the Parish Councillors will all vote. The successful applicant will be the one with a majority vote. In the event of a draw, the Chairman will have the casting vote.
