**Temporary Traffic Restriction Order 2024
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Section 16a as Amended by The Road
Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994**

**In the Parish of Rocklands
On 9th June 2024**

Temporary Restriction of Traffic Movement

Norfolk County Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the Rocklands D Day Celebration, they intend to make a Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic on the 33034 The Street from 152m southwest of junction with C135 Mill Lane to 123m northwest of junction with 33037 Low Lane in the PARISH OF ROCKLANDS

The Order will come into effect on 9th June 2024 and will remain in force for 1 day. The road will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency and pedestrian access) on 9th June 2024 between 12:00 and 16:00 for the duration of the event. Restriction on traffic will only be enforced until normal traffic flow can be maintained.

Where appropriate during the period of the closure temporary suspension of existing permanent Traffic Orders may be imposed

Alternative route will be via: C135 Mill Lane / Rocklands Road, 33038 St Andrews Lane (known locally as Mere Road), 33037 Low Lane and vice versa.

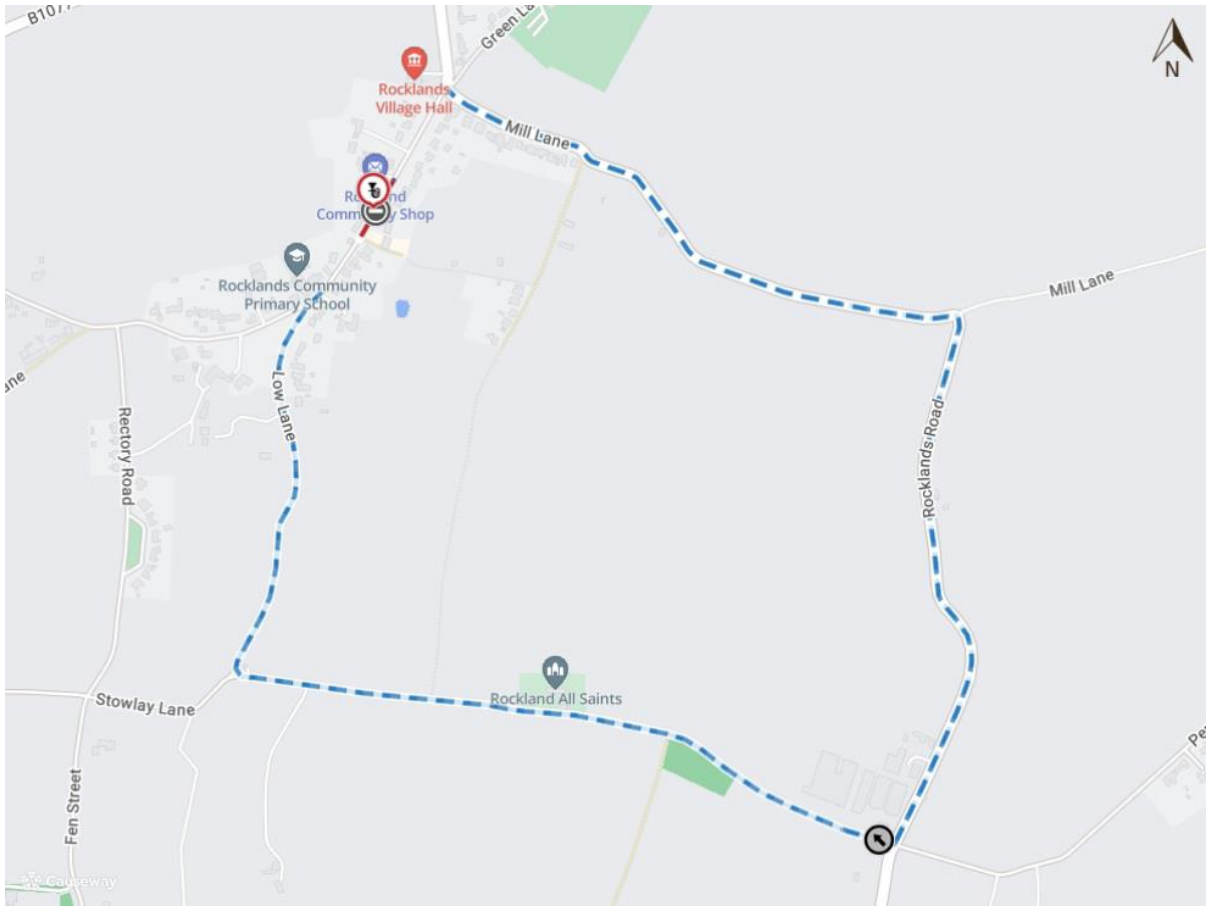
The promoter of the event is Rocklands Parish Council
